XIAHA TRODEN: "SIN PALABRAS"



EL INNOVADOR DUO LATINOAMERICANO LLEGA PARA REVOLUCIONAR **EL MUNDO DE LA MUSICA**

Las notas electrónicas y clásicas con un giro tropical e influencias de ritmos afro-americanos, son los ingredientes principales que caracterizan al dueto Mexicano-Cubano **Xiah Troden**,

una nueva propuesta que promete revolucionar el mundo de la música.

La banda alternativa surge luego de que el cantante y músico mexicano de 28 años Don Isaac Garza, conociera por casualidad al músico cubano de 54 años Leo Pestana, en el lobby de un hotel en [México](#) mientras éste tocaba el piano. En un instante, ambos descubrieron que a pesar de la diferencia en edad, nacionalidad, culturas e influencias, compartían una visión única en cuanto a la música. *"Hubo química, en cuanto a personalidad, gustos y sobretodo la manera de ver y tratar la música ,"* expresó Leo sobre [el encuentro](#). Unas semanas después, el dúo compuso su primer tema "Esta Copa" y el resto es historia. Don Isaac y Leo trabajaron juntos en la composición y grabación de su primer álbum titulado **SIN PALABRAS**.

El álbum fue lanzado de manera independiente bajo el sello Seleкто® Records, a principios del 2011 a través de varias tiendas digitales incluyendo [iTunes](#), destacando **SIN PALABRAS** entre los discos favoritos en la categoría alternativa.

La ecléctica mezcla de electrónica, son, pop y danzón que conforma el original álbum, ha cautivado a todos aquellos quienes han tenido la oportunidad de escucharlo. El primer corte titulado "[Mira Negra](#)," ha causado sensación en el popular portal de videos [YouTube](#), gracias a su video musical el cual muestra un metafórico viaje musical hacia lo desconocido en un mundo épico y surrealista. El video ha registrado más de 63,000 visitas hasta el momento, todo antes de ser promocionado en cualquier canal de videos. El innovador dúo con enigmático nombre pretende transmitir un mensaje de fusión y evolución musical el cual forma parte del espíritu de la banda: *"Xiaha Troden es un nombre muy fuerte que nosotros inventamos...queremos hacer algo que no exista, como lo que estamos haciendo con la música, todo original, todo diferente, todo único"* fueron [las palabras](#) de Don Isaac refiriéndose al peculiar nombre del grupo y al estilo musical.

Las letras de cada canción juegan un papel importante ya que a pesar de ser autobiográficas, se adaptan a situaciones o emociones que afectan a la humanidad día tras día. *"Nuestra música es su música y esperamos que se diviertan y la disfruten tanto como nosotros"* Leo Pestana.

Con este lanzamiento, los integrantes de Xiaha Troden iniciarán su primera gira promocional en las principales ciudades en los Estados Unidos.

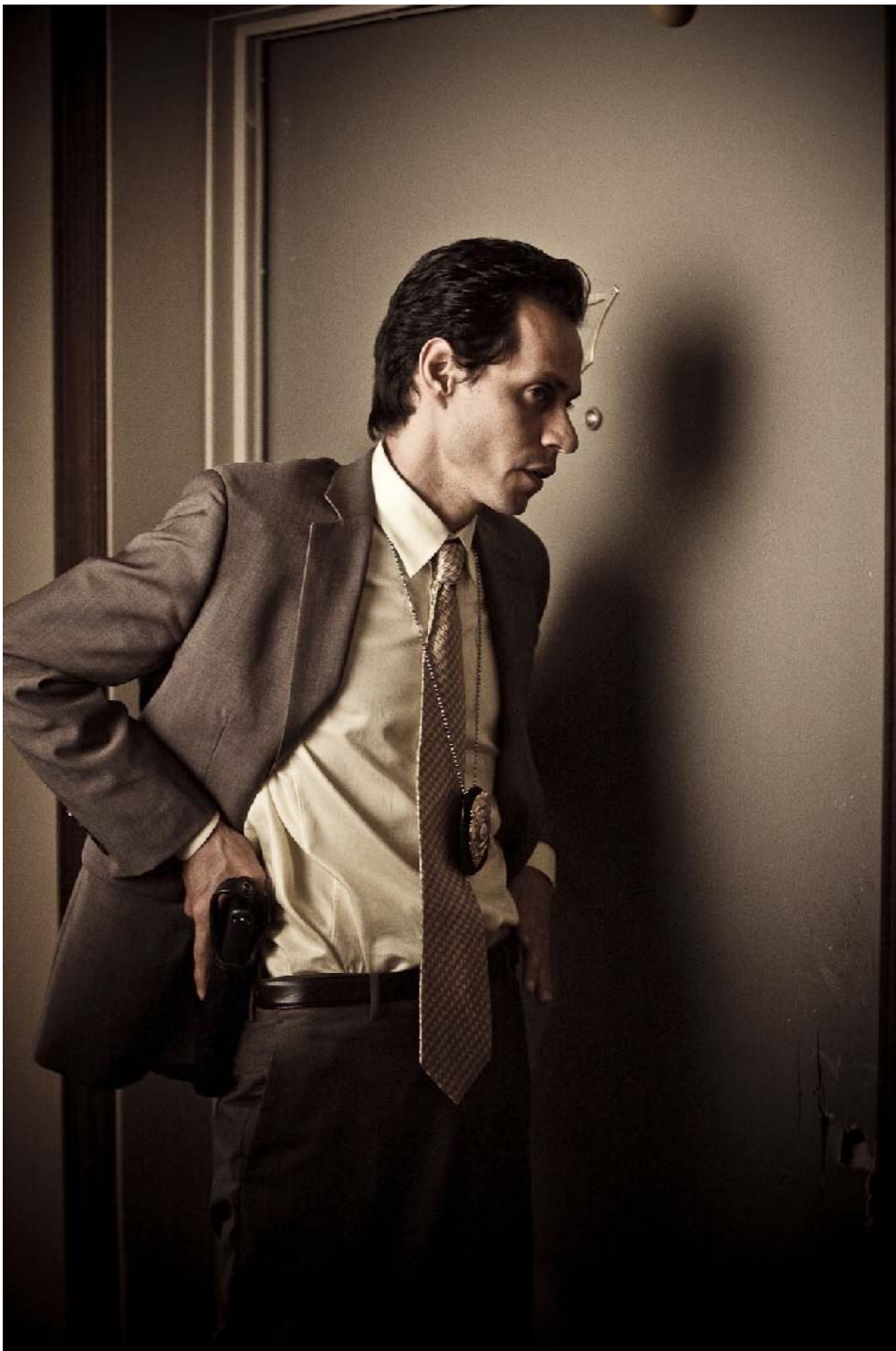

**Grammy® Winner Marc Anthony Joins Cast of
HAWTHORNE, TNT's Hit Drama Series Starring and
Executive-Produced by Jada Pinkett Smith**

Third Season Set to Launch in June



Grammy-winning recording artist and actor **Marc Anthony** has joined the cast of TNT's **HAWTHORNE**, the powerful drama series starring and executive-produced by **Jada Pinkett Smith** (*The Women*, *The Matrix* trilogy). Anthony will reprise the newly expanded role of Police Detective Nick Renata, the character he introduced as a guest star in two episodes last season. **HAWTHORNE** is scheduled to return for its third season [this June](#).



Anthony joins HAWTHORNE as a series regular just as Pinkett Smith's Christina Hawthorne, Chief Nursing Officer of James River Hospital, struggles with news that she is pregnant. The two developed a strong bond last season while Renata investigated a pair of criminal cases involving the hospital. But Christina, whose on-again, off-again romance with Dr. Tom Wakefield ([Michael Vartan – Alias](#)) has been a mess of [mixed signals](#) and [bad timing](#), told Nick she was not ready to jump into a new relationship.

As a recording artist, Anthony has sold more than 12 million albums worldwide, making him the top-selling salsa artist of all time. He has been awarded numerous gold and platinum record certifications from the [Recording Industry Association of America \(RIAA\)](#). His Grammy accolades began with a 1998 Grammy for Best Tropical Latin Performance for "Contra La Corriente," followed with a 1999 [Latin Grammy](#) for [Song of the Year](#) for "Dimelo." In 2004, he earned a Grammy for Best Latin Pop Album for [Amar Sin Mentiras](#) and a Latin Grammy for Best Salsa Album for [Valió la Pena](#). He won his third Latin Grammy for the 2008 album [El Cantante](#). Last summer, the [Miami Dolphins](#) minority owner released his latest album, [Iconos](#), an all-Spanish [ballad collection](#) produced with Julio Reyes. The platinum album held the #1 spot on the [Billboard charts](#) for six consecutive weeks and earned him his 12th [Latin Grammy nomination](#).

Anthony's acting career includes roles in [Martin Scorsese's Bringing Out the Dead](#) and [Tony](#)

Scott's *Man on Fire*. Starring opposite wife Jennifer Lopez, Anthony played Puerto Rican salsa pioneer Héctor Lavoe in Leon Ichaso's biopic *El Cantante*. He also starred opposite Salma Hayak in the television film *In the Time of the Butterflies*. In 1997, Anthony made his Broadway debut in Paul Simon's musical *The Capeman*.

HAWTHORNE premiered on TNT in summer 2009. Last summer, the second season averaged 3.7 million viewers and ranked as one of cable's top scripted series among women. Created by Emmy® winner John Masius (*St. Elsewhere*), HAWTHORNE is produced by Sony Pictures Television in association with Pinkett Smith's Overbrook Entertainment and Jamie Tarses' FanFare Productions. The Autry Celebrates Earth Day: Sustainable Living in the West

A Native American Perspective on Earth-Friendly Living

Sunday, May 1, 2011, 11:00 am–5:00 pm

The Autry National Center celebrates Earth Day with an outdoor festival designed to inspire simple changes for a healthier planet. Drawing on Native cultures and traditions, this family-friendly event includes local environmental groups, community organizations, and hobbyists offering practical tips on how to can get started on an Earth-friendly path.

Backyard farmers, gardening experts, green-build architects, and wildlife experts will be on hand to share their methods for providing balance among the plants, animals, humans, bugs, and bees. Witness a ladybug release on the Autry's South Lawn and enjoy Indigenous and world music throughout the day including Hawaii's own Shawn Ishimoto, Peru's Ciro Hurtado, and multiethnic Quetzal Guerrero's Brazilian rhythms. Native American artist Bernie Granados (Apache/Zacatec) will host a community mural project with inspiring messages for Mother Earth.

Visit the Kid's Planet area for fun and games led by the Southern California Indian Center's John Bradley (Cherokee/Comanche) featuring a Hook and Hoop Race. Museum teachers will lead a weaving activity using recycled materials and gourd artist Nadiya Littlewarrior (Potawatomi Nation) will demonstrate how to make Cherokee gourd birdhouses. Next, learn Native dances including the community Round Dance and Snake Dance accompanied by a Native drum group. On the South Lawn, visit with some wildlife friends from America's Teaching Zoo at Moorpark College and stick around for a ladybug release led by environmental science teacher Janine Peterson.

Head indoors to Wells Fargo Theater for a breathtaking display of works by Pulitzer Prize-winning landscape photographer Jack Dykinga, Earth-related film screenings sponsored by LA Skins Fest and the Sierra Club, and panel discussions. Inside the Autry, take an eco-tour of the galleries and watch recycle artist Luis Villanueva turn recyclable materials into marvelous works of art in the Autry lobby. Native storyteller Abel Silva (Juaneño, Gabrieliño, Kumeyaay) will recount oral histories, tell the story of Rainbow Bridge, and share other tales that encourage us to be kind to the Earth. Then visit the new *Skydreamers* exhibition featuring images of planet Earth taken from hot air balloons to outer space.

After working up an appetite, head over to the Autry Cafe for Earth-friendly vegan, organic, and Native food. Be sure to dispose of your leftovers in the handy green compost bins. Shoppers can visit the Autry Store to purchase unique jewelry made from flea market finds and repurposed old jewelry by Tara Gasparian and Jane Bird of Design Imports.
